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Nueces County Selects Sec-Ops, Inc. for security officer services contract in Corpus Christi, TX.

Corpus Christi, Texas—February 3rd, 2016— The Nueces county security team evaluated the proposals submitted by six security companies and recommended Sec-Ops based on our proven performance, quality of service and capabilities to provide the armed and unarmed security personnel required to meet the security mission. The Sec-Ops proposal represented the best value for the county with an immediate mobilization capability. The county commissioners approved the recommendation and unanimously voted to contract with Sec-Ops for a one year contract plus four option years. Previously, Sec-Ops was awarded an emergency services security officer contract that commenced on December 7th 2015 by Nueces County purchasing. Based on the rapid response of Sec-Ops, the county was provided the immediate relief of the deputies and bailiff's to return to their primary mission with minimal impact to the county budget. At the close of the emergency services contract on 20 December, staff evaluated Sec-Ops performance as outstanding. It was later announced at the county commissioners meeting that the security contract would go out for bid and issued a termination letter to the existing contractor.
